PUBLIC CONSULTATION

A Strategic Regeneration Framework (SRF) for MIX MANCHESTER is being promoted by a joint venture partnership which includes a portfolio of clients represented by Columbia Threadneedle Real Estate, Manchester Airports Group (MAG), Beijing Construction Engineering Group International (BCEGI), and Greater Manchester Pension Fund (GMPF).

An 8-week public consultation is currently underway to share the proposed MIX MANCHESTER SRF and listen to your comments and feedback. All comments received will be reviewed and reflected in the final SRF where appropriate.

The SRF repurposes Airport City North as MIX MANCHESTER, to bring forwards a new science, innovation and manufacturing campus in an unrivalled strategic location. The SRF will guide development to ensure that proposals come forward in a coordinated manner in line with the overarching vision and objectives.

MIX MANCHESTER will be a highly sustainable mixed-use development, providing up to 8,000 new jobs, boosting productivity, promoting opportunities for local people, and supporting the continued growth of the region's innovation sector. The masterplan has been developed to increase permeability and encourage linkages between the site and local community so that the benefits are accessible to all.

The SRF is located c.400m to the north of Manchester Airport and is surrounded to the north by the well-established residential community of Wythenshawe and to the east by the existing employment uses at Manchester Business Park.
